understanding of the environmental crisis this book introduces the concept of hegemony into environmental politics using the concept to elucidate the political economic and social alliance that sustains our belief in industrial expansionism the ecological crisis of the late twentieth century presents a challenge to the very foundations of this alliance the hegemonic system reacts to a threat to its structure by producing social myths that provide a common sense understanding of the threat smith examines one such social myth the contemporary phenomenon known as green marketing and how it came to reinforce rather than challenge the ethics of productivism by analysing green marketing as it relates primarily to the early 1990s corporate campaigns of companies such as mcdonald s shell chemicals and mobil chemical co smith demonstrates how these voices weave together an understanding of green consumerism using familiar language from economic and liberal democratic discourses the myth of green marketing is an original and important contribution to the field of environmental studies as the first book on green marketing it is sure to raise controversy with its unique discussion of the cultural and social aspects of environmental issues

why does the myth of the fall continue to matter in an increasingly secularised world why do we continue to imagine a point where everything went wrong and why must we imagine that things were once better than they are now modern political theodicies repeatedly play to the myth of the fall as empowering human authorship promising to take back control or make america great again the myth of the fall is so absorbed into western culture that we sometimes don t even notice it s there let alone think about why and how it has persisted through secularisation it is often pernicious playing on feelings of innate supremacy and lost dominion linda freedman shows that it is also creative the first act of disobedience and resistance which set new human stories in motion and gave narrative shape to existence nineteenth century writers were so steeped in christian traditions that the fall remained an ineluctable structure of thought and even

those who resisted or tried to secularise its doctrinal orthodoxies tended to affirm its logic it was a political social and cultural force as well as an aesthetic preoccupation a way of reflecting on the limitations and possibilities of art and literature driving innovations in prose poetry and the novel rethinking narratives of american exceptionalism with transatlantic and anti racist writings freedman captures some of the most theologically imaginative and aesthetically and politically interesting textures of the fall in nineteenth century literature the myth of the fall survives as much more than a judgmental and repressive social mechanism and mattered to people living vastly different lives this is partly due to the adaptability and force of its narrative logic and partly because it gives narrative time the feel of a quest an infinite search for meaning the fall holds onto the otherworldly and the unworldly it serves as a formal metalanguage a residually and sometimes explicitly religious aesthetic an origin myth of modernity a source for being in time

this book examines the phenomenon of the russian intelligentsia as a cultural story or myth it focuses on one of the most important and influential groups of russian intellectuals the 1960s generation or sixtiers who devoted their lives to defending socialism with a human face authored perestroika and were subsequently demonized when the reforms failed

studies of opera film television and literature have demonstrated how constructions of madness may be referenced in order to stigmatise but also liberate protagonists in ways that reinforce or challenge contemporaneous notions of normality but to date very little research has been conducted on how madness is represented in popular music in an effort to redress this imbalance nicola spelman identifies links between the anti psychiatry movement and representations of madness in popular music of the 1960s and 1970s analysing the various ways in which ideas critical of institutional psychiatry are embodied both verbally and musically in specific songs by david bowie lou reed pink floyd alice cooper the beatles and elton john she concentrates on meanings that may be made at the point of reception as a

consequence of ideas about madness that were circulating at the time these ideas are then linked to contemporary conventions of musical expression in order to illustrate certain interpretative possibilities supporting evidence comes from popular musicological analysis incorporating discourse analysis and social semiotics and investigation of socio historical context the uniqueness of the period in question is demonstrated by means of a more generalised overview of songs drawn from a variety of styles and eras that engage with the topic of madness in diverse and often conflicting ways the conclusions drawn reveal the extent to which anti psychiatric ideas filtered through into popular culture offering insights into popular music s ability to question general suppositions about madness alongside its potential to bring issues of men s madness into the public arena as an often neglected topic for discussion
